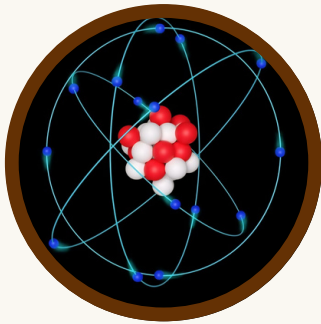

PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. **Registration:** Click or Scan the Google Form to register.

2. **Theme Selection:**

- Choose any one theme from the six given themes.
- Selection can be based on your interest; it is not mandatory to select a theme related to your discipline.

(For example: A student with a science background can also choose a theme from commerce, arts, or law.)

3. **Form Submission & Payment:** Fill the registration form completely and make the payment.

4. **Problem Statements:**

- The problem statements corresponding to your selected theme will be sent to you via email.
- Please ensure your Email ID is entered correctly to receive the problem statements.

5. **Mentor Selection:** After receiving the problem statements, select your mentor.

6. **Paper Preparation:**

Prepare your research paper based on the problem statements, with the mentor's signature included.

7. **Submission of Paper:**

- Save your paper as a PDF with the file name format:
